

## MINORS:

Students may substitute a minor and 14 hours of Professional Studies courses for the additional major. The regular courses for General Education, Bible/Theology, and Professional Studies will remain the same. They may also take the required courses for a minor in addition to their major. This procedure would provide them with qualifications in an additional field of study. If a student has already taken a required course in the minor to fulfill a requirement for the major, then an elective in the minor's field of study may be taken to replace it. If no electives are available, then the student may take another professional studies course in its place. To receive the minor in addition to a major, a student must take the number of hours required by that minor in addition to the number of hours required for the major degree program.

- Demonstrate a solid understanding of the Biblical basis, historical developments, and current trends in world evangelism;
- Draw upon insights gained through fieldwork and other cross-cultural experiences;
- Gain an awareness of various cultures and the major world religions.
