### CTK WORSHIP LEADER POSITION

We are seeking a person of great faith who desires to be mentored in ministry and has music leading gifts. The primary responsibility will be developing a worship team and providing music for our worship services on Sunday mornings. This is a great opportunity for someone who is exploring a call to ministry and would like to be mentored for pastoral ministry and has musical giftedness. This individual will be expected to engage in the ministry and help grow the congregation spiritually and numerically.

Christ the King is an Anglican Church in the Ancient-Future tradition. We are an evangelical-liturgical congregation, whose music is blended. Our primary focus is to reach the unchurched, and the new-unchurched, the 45+ generation that has dropped out of church.

CtK is a ministry that embraces and engages in the sacred and sacramental, sharing the Scriptures and God's extravagant grace. Currently, we are a small congregation with a ministry center that is ready and able to grow with God's outpouring.

The individual we are seeking will work closely with our pastor in the planning of music. We use video projection and are open to implementing a variety of musical instruments to enhance our songs of praise. At the present time we own a keyboard and a jimbay and have a few singers in our worship team.

- Holds to the authenticity and authority of the Scriptures as the Word of God sufficient for salvation and maturing in the faith.
- Affirms the historic statements of faith expressed in the Apostles' and Nicene Creeds.
- Has musical and vocal skills, organizational abilities to develop a music ministry and a desire for a mentoring relationship. Our primary worship takes place on Sunday mornings in the DeWitt area.

Throughout the year we do have three other special services (Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and Christmas Eve).

This is a paid part-time position. Anticipated hours required: 5-6 per week, includes Sunday morning and a practice time.
