

New Life Church of Christ Preacher/Outreach Description

Purpose:

• The purpose of the Preacher/Outreach position of New Life Church of Christ is to assist in preaching/teaching duties of the church, pastoral care of the congregation, and lead the congregation in

evangelism efforts to reach out to our local community.

- Our primary goals are to reach the de-churched in our community (people who are used to go to church, but not going anywhere now), make new disciples, equip the congregation to make and teach disciples for evangelism (numerical growth) and spiritual growth, to be a Bible-teaching and practicing church.
- At the present, we have a very active group of women. The women's ministry has taken the lead on benevolence/charity work and other ministries of the church. The person that is called to join our body will be expected to equip, enable, and partner with the men to match this involvement. Time Expectations:
- We realize the hours of the Preaching/Outreach position may vary from week to week but should average about 20-25 hours per week with most of those hours on the field.
- This position reports to Leadership Team and will give a monthly report at the monthly business meeting. Breakdown of Expectations:
- In function, the Preaching/Outreach minister will act as the primary minister for the church.
- However, we believe that we are not a church with a minister, but that we are a church of ministers.
- Our leadership team is willing to assist with the ministry duties of the church (teaching, preaching, visitation, and pastoral care) so the expectation is not solely upon "paid" staff, but at the same time, we need someone who will see to the ministry needs of the church are met and to focus efforts on future growth.
- While it is assumed time spent in this position may vary from week to week, a possible breakdown of ministry needs may look this way:
- a. Pastoral care: 35 percent of time
- b. Evangelism/outreach 40 percent of time
- c. Preaching/teaching: 25 percent of time (preaching about 2-3 times a month; teaching Wednesday night and other needs).

Pastoral Care Needs:

- Assist with hospital visitation, in-home visits, senior's ministry and provide encouragement and shepherding as needed to all members of the congregation.
- We need a person who will see the worth and dignity of all people and care for others deeply.
- Keep the leadership team informed of any information needed for the shepherding of the church.
- Assist in funerals and visitations as requested.

Evangelism/Outreach:

- Take the lead on follow up on visitors and potential members (including the de-churched as described above).
- Assist in discipleship training and development using our material that helps to equip our people for reaching others and to grow in faith.
- Help develop programs for teaching both evangelism and nurturing skills for numerical and spiritual growth.
- Help to promote the church and create awareness in the community. Represent the congregation at community events as needed.

While these are the primary functions of the position, other secondary goals can be done as you have time.
