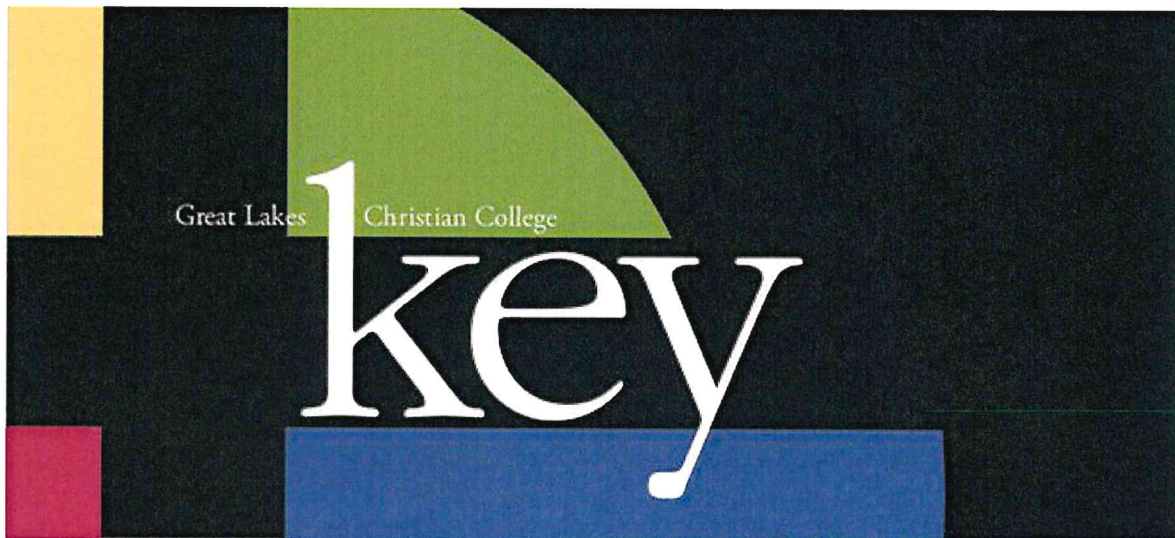

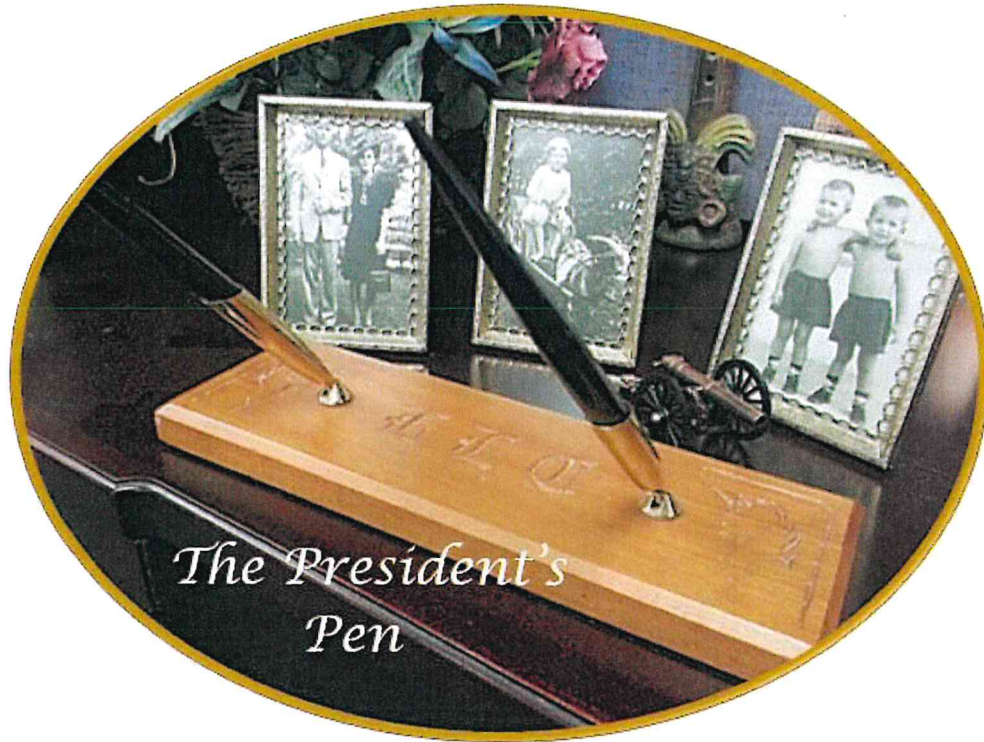

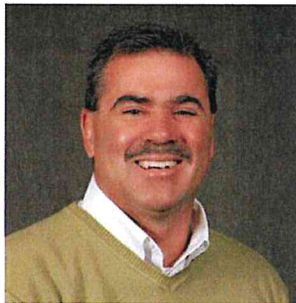


"Jumpin' Jehoshaphat!"
