Enrollment Increases 6.7%!

The new school year began on August 22. Students, faculty, and staff joined alumni and supporters from area churches in an evening

We ended last school year with a budget surplus and graduated 16 vocational and marketplace ministers. To become sustainable and return to good standing with our accrediting association, that trend must continue. Enrollment must climb. Giving to the College must grow.

Our enrollment increased this fall by 6.7%. With college enrollment across the region declining, that represents a significant increase. When our next online cycle begins in October, we expect another gain in enrollment.

increase again this year. For us to operate in the black, this year's giving must exceed last year's by \$250,000. We need sixty individuals to join our Log Cabin Society. We need more churches to begin supporting GLCC or to increase the support they provide.

I believe America is poised for a resurgence in Christian higher education. As more families want a college where students are educated instead of indoctrinated, GLCC will have an impact. I am committed to leading a college that is awake but not woke. Where we celebrate diversity while avoiding division. Where students have their faith built up instead of torn down.

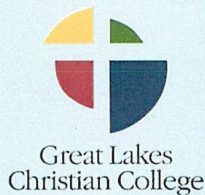


Support the Mission of GLCC through the Log Cabin Society

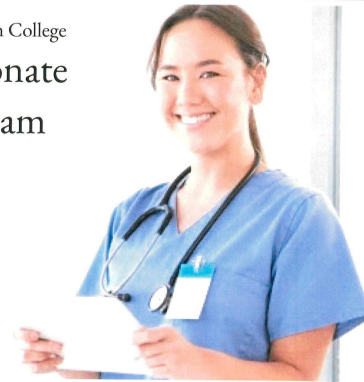
