Year-end Charitable Reminders Phil Beavers VP of Institutional Advancement

We are approaching the end of 2022 and many are thinking through their plan for charitable giving. God has provided the resources that are in our care and our desire should be to make the best decisions and be the best stewards of those resources.

Let me give you a few tips for this time of year:

1. Whether you write a check or use an online portal, be sure to get your gift in before December 31, 2022. For gifts to be included as a charitable deduction for that year, it must be postmarked (if check), and transaction posted (if credit card) by December 31.

2. Take advantage of tax-free

gifts. An IRA owner who wishes to make a (QCD) qualified charitable distribution for 2022 should contact their IRA trustee soon. Each year, an IRA owner age 70 1/2 or over can exclude from gross income up to \$100,000 of these QCD. Remember that a qualified charitable distribution becomes tax-free as long as they're paid directly from the IRA to the charitable organization.



3. Take advantage of doubling your gift through your organization and their matching gift program. This is something you will need to ask about to see if your company will match your charitable gifts. For example, Auto-Owners will match your gift one for one and Coca-Cola will match two for one. This multiplies the value of your donation.
