Position Summary:

The Family Ministry Lead is called to help kids and students take next steps with God through the practices of knowing God, growing with others, and changing the world. This person will oversee the campus family ministry from birth through high school. This will require having a “Do whatever it takes” mentality, being devoted to learning, and a willingness to be part of the big picture of what 2|42 Kids & Students are doing in a multi-site context.

What To Expect From Us:

- Clear expectations for your leadership, ministry impact, and work-flow
- A work environment that will challenge and inspire you to be the best follower of Christ you can be (*ex: Jesus first, then spouse, then family, then ministry*)

As a 2|42 Community Church Staff Member:

All Ministry positions at 2|42 work in a team. You will need to work well with existing team members and align to decisions that are made. A good team member has open and honest conversations, allows tensions to exist within the team but always supports the team's decisions and directions outside of the team meetings. Relational intelligence will be a key component to ensuring collaboration with the ministry teams.

Job Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Lead student ministry by overseeing weekly programming, curriculum adaptation, small group management, team leadership, camp experiences and event execution.
- Lead Kids pastors to accomplish the ministry goals and strategy of 2|42 Kids.
- Production, development, organization, and upkeep of all team training resources.
- Collaborate with 2|42 kids and student staff across campuses in order to maintain alignment where it is required.
- Be an innovative team player and have an unstoppable mindset when it comes to helping kids and students take next steps with God. (We LOVE solution-minded people!)
- Be a “Leader of Leaders” who grows the ministry to reach as many kids and students as possible and recruit high-capacity volunteers/leaders by helping them live in to their purpose.
- Track and measure the growth and effectiveness of your ministry.
- Work with Campus Pastor and Ministry Directors to help set & achieve term goals, meeting monthly with Campus Pastor to review goals and be held accountable for performance.

Position Responsibilities

1. Oversee ACC's Children's Ministry (Birth-5th Grade) by recruiting and training volunteers, maintaining a yearly calendar of programs and events, administering curriculum, etc.
 - Provide oversight of the established Children's Ministry programs (CHAMP/nursery on Wednesdays and classes/nursery on Sundays)
 - Assume the position of primary teacher
 - Recruit and train volunteer teachers and helpers
 - Oversee ACC's offering of childcare opportunities when necessary
 - Oversee ACC's children's ministry policies, handbook, etc.
 - Oversee ACC's children's ministry spaces (classrooms, storage, etc.)

- Develop a balanced calendar of programs and events that reflects ACC's **Mission** (transforming all people with the love of Jesus) and **Vision** (discipleship, community, ministry, and worship)
 - Direct an annual summer VBS program
 - Work with the ACC staff to plan the annual Fall Block Party and other seasonal events
- Maintain a partnership with Lake James Christian Camp & Retreat Center by actively providing opportunities to participate in camps and retreats
- Build and maintain relationships with local children's ministers and children's ministry networks
- Oversee the administration of scheduling and communicating with all children's ministry volunteers

2. Build and maintain relationships with children, students, and adults, both churched and unchurched
 - Be intentionally present in our church gatherings *and* our community in order to create connections that enable our mission to be accomplished
3. Maintain a Family Ministry partnership with ACC's Associate Minister
 - Participate in the planning and execution of Family Ministry events

General Responsibilities

1. Participate in all scheduled staff and leadership meetings
2. Oversee the development and maintenance of ministry budgets
3. Assist with other ministry opportunities as needed based on spiritual gifting and ability/experience
4. Maintain regular office hours in accordance with the employment agreement

2. Bible College/University Graduate preferred
